

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:  
TAX BILLS REGARDING SUBDIVIDED PARCELS**

If you had sold or purchased a subdivided parcel of land and did not receive a revised tax bill or a tax bill for your newly purchased property you should contact the Tax Collector/Receiver or contact person for that taxing jurisdiction. Parcels that are subdivided and filed with the County after March 1<sup>st</sup> will not appear until the following years' assessment roll; therefore no tax bill will exist for newly created parcels. If either party regarding a subdivided parcel needs to have an apportionment completed you will need to submit a request in writing to the Assessor's Office in order for an apportionment of the assessed value of the last filed assessment roll to be apportioned. The values given **DO NOT** reflect what a subdivided assessment will be for the following assessment roll year for parcels involved.
