TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 20, 2007

SPECIAL MEETING: The Town Board of the Town of Elbridge met in regular session on November 20, 2007 at 4:00 PM in the Town Municipal Building, Route 31, Jordan, New York.

Supervisor Bush called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENT: Supervisor Ken Bush Jr., Councilor George Betts, Councilor Bruce Ralston, Councilor Vern Richardson and Councilor Rita Dygert.

OTHERS PRESENT: Robert Hill, Jr., Dan Beckner and D. Karen Platten, Town Clerk.

Board discussed the replacement for the recreation director, as Vivian Wilson's retirement is effective December 31, 2007. Advertise in the Advocate, Citizen, Post Standard and Shopping Guide. Job would not be civil service if under 24 hrs/week at a salary of \$14,000. Flexible hours. Discussed having advice from the recreation commission and having them set in as observers on the interviews. Responses due by December 10th.

On a motion of Councilor Richardson, seconded by Bruce Ralston the following resolution was

Resolved: that the Town Board of the Town of Elbridge authorize the advertising for a part-time Recreation Supervisor with letters of interest sent to the Town Clerk by December 10, 2007.

Councilor Ralston brought up the NYSEG Solutions Plan and we have been charged tax and shouldn't been charged. Corrected now.

Brown's Tree Service is going to donate some trees for screening around the soil pile and salt shed.

Councilor Richardson has received the security audit results – many papers.

Councilor Ralston said he has given the floor plan layout to the office personnel to look over. Also have asked Plumley for an estimate.

Supervisor Bush said Verizon has picked up a permit for the landfill site.

Councilor Betts said the letters for the waterline proposals have gone out.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Robert Hill of 5700 Fikes Road – re: asked about a water line up to Fikes Road as the town is doing water lines.

Dan Beckner of 5408 Hamilton Road – also inquiring about a water line. Said he knew in Lavonia they were able to have 85% of their water lines funded.

Supervisor Bush answered that they were responding to the petition from Sunview Drive. The other was for a transmission line for Hart Lot, which the town has monies from
