

TOWN OF ELBRIDGE  
TOWN BOARD MEETING  
JANUARY 20<sup>TH</sup>, 2010

**REGULAR MEETING:** The Town Board of the Town of Elbridge met in regular session on January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 7:00 PM in the Town Municipal Building, Route 31, Jordan, N.Y.

Supervisor Bush called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PRESENT:** Supervisor Ken Bush, Councilor George Betts, Councilor William Kuhn, and Councilor Rita Dygert.

**ABSENT:** Councilor Vern Richardson

**OTHERS PRESENT:** Town Attorney Dirk Oudemool, Gretchen and Dan Leary, Tom McGuire, Dana Anthonson, Dave Rinaldo, Todd Rinaldo, Dan Conroy, and Debra Stapleton, Town Clerk.

**ADOPT MINUTES:** On a motion of Councilor Dygert, seconded by Councilor Kuhn, to dispense with the reading of the minutes of January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and adopt minutes with a revision regarding Roger Darling's MEO pay.

On a motion of Councilor Kuhn, seconded by Councilor Dygert the following resolution was

Resolved: the Elbridge Town Board resolves to amend rate of pay for Roger Darling from \$16.25 an hour to \$16.84.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Dana Anthonson wanted to revisit a comment he'd made at an earlier meeting regarding laws put into place by the Town that he would like to see revised or eliminated, and in particular Chapter 37, which deals with temporary storage. He feels the law is too strict, and would include people having tents in their yards, and neighbors could complain about neighbors. The Supervisor said they would take his comments into consideration, and address it at a latter time.

**NEW BUSINESS:** There was a press conference held at the Village of Elbridge re: the LT2 water grant. The Town's grant was \$200,000. to construct a new transmission line for the Hart Lot Water District and will be seeking additional funds from Community Development to get us closer to estimated costs.

Resolved: that Supervisor Bush be authorized to sign the Annual Software Support Contracts with Williamson Law Book Company for a total cost of \$2530, which includes Highway Superintendent, Building & Codes, Municipal Accounting, Town Clerk & Tax Collection, Water/Sewer Billing and Payroll.

On a motion of Councilor Kuhn, seconded by Councilor Dygert the following resolution was

Resolution 44-10

Resolved: the Elbridge Town Board authorizes Supervisor Bush to sign the three year Post-Closure Landfill Monitoring and Reporting Services for 2010-2012 at a cost of \$17,900.

**AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:**

Dan Conroy asked the Supervisor about the grant money for the Hart Lot Water District, and if it was part of the LT2 plant. Dan also asked about the Landfill reporting and cost of the monitoring.

Tom McGuire reiterated Dana Anthonson's earlier concerns re: the temporary storage units, or PODS, and if there are time frames and what they're used for. The Supervisor said he could get a copy of the law to him, and assured him the intent was to limit the amount of time you could keep them.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** On a motion of Councilor Betts, seconded by Councilor Kuhn, the Town Board moved into executive session regarding contract negotiations at 7:25 PM. The Board returned to regular session at 9:25 PM.

**ADJOURNMENT:** On a motion of Councilor Dygert, seconded by Councilor Betts, the meeting was adjourned at 9:25 PM. UC
