CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Bush called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM and Dana Anthonson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENT: Councilor George Betts, Councilor Bill Kuhn, Councilor Rita Dygert, Councilor Vern Richardson, and Supervisor Ken Bush.

ADOPT MINUTES: On a motion of Councilor Richardson, seconded by Councilor Dygert the minutes from June 2nd, 2010 were approved. UC

OLD BUSINESS: Councilor Kuhn received a letter from NYS DOT regarding a request for a traffic study on Rte. 5 between Hamilton and the county line, and they decided to extend the 45 MPH speed limit beyond the Tessy Plastic Main Exit, and determined closing the majority of passing lanes is also appropriate.

NEW BUSINESS: Summer meeting schedule for July and August.

Councilor Kuhn: DCO, Steve Remp wants to amend fees and penalties for dogs. Also, re: buildings and grounds- Ms. Zelias wanted to donate a picnic table (boy scouts) and Dennis and Bill are working on the lighting. Weed killer was applied, but not all beds were covered.

Councilor Richardson: spoke with Assessor Karakas and she has requested more help. Paige will be able to provide more time. Also, requested an updated computer for help upgrading the assessing process.

Councilor Dygert: the JET transportation committee met and have finalized procedures for emergency situations and revised forms. The first annual JET volunteer recognition program- to be held in conjunction with the senior summer picnic is on July 20th at Carpenter's Brook. Will have the JET at the Taste of Elbridge on June 23rd. The JE Community Center will be receptive to many bicyclists coming through on July 14th. Met with reps from Northland Communications, and Bob Herrmann, regarding a new phone system. Would like to discuss the updated zoning map at the July 7th meeting

Supervisor Bush: received a call from a realtor interested in 85 acres for sale surrounding the Summit Ford property on Rte. 5, and he asked about a waterline for this property. There are environmental concerns with this, and the developer would have to pay for this line. Complimented Councilor Kuhn on the landscaping at the front of the building. Cautioned us all that next year will be very challenging as we approach budget time.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: short discussion with Dan Conroy re: the high school project and the storm water part- the DOT is requiring them to bore under the road and it's a huge project and expense.
