TOWN BOARD MEETING
JUNE 2nd, 2010

CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Bush called the meeting to order at 7PM, and Bob Herrmann led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENT: Councilor Rita Dygert, Councilor Vern Richardson, and Supervisor Bush.

ABSENT: Councilor Bill Kuhn, and Councilor George Betts.

ADOPT MINUTES: On a motion by Councilor Richardson, seconded by Councilor Dygert, the minutes from May 19, 2010 were approved.

MOTION TO PAY BILLS: Councilor Richardson, seconded by Councilor Dygert made a motion that General Bills Abstract #5, Vouchers # 266-346 in the amount of \$64,203.24 were ordered paid and Highway Bills, Abstract # 5, Vouchers # 75H-94H in the amount of \$16,569.96 were also ordered paid for a total disbursement of \$80,773.20.

GUESTS: Dana Anthonson of Pine Street, Jordan, asked to speak to the board regarding two ordinances. One is about a noise ordinance that's been discussed, and one is the POD/temporary storage ordinance.

Assessor: Ms. Karakas stated grievance day went well. The Supervisor appreciates her availability to residents. Assessor thanked the Board of Assessment Review for their understanding during the process.

Highway Superintendent: Dennis said they'd start paving Reeves Road next week. All three buildings are now in compliance with the PESH inspection. Trash program going well.

Code Enforcement Officer: Bob will be going to the briefing on the FEMA maps June 9th at the Pirro Convention Center with Don Jordan.

Dog Control Officer: briefly discussed an enumeration.

Outreach Worker: Leo helped people recently with food stamps- not just seniors need help- also people with disabilities.

Historian: business is picking up because of summer, and will be helping a Cornell student doing work on a thesis on canal parks in the 30's.

Recreation Director: report is on file. Will be getting proposals for mowing at Seymour Lofft Park.

Planning Board: Tessy purchased the old Syroco plant. Traffic study being conducted on Rte. 5 and the Tessy campus.
